- Judy said that there were enough stuffed animals for this year but asked that if anyone had some to donate she would accept them. Also, she is concerned that a pilot may or may not be available so she would like to know who and how many may be on site to provide this service. - John asked that someone contact the media to get coverage for the Fly-In.
- Roger will contact the York Dispatch and other media to see about advertisement.
- Ron mentioned that the Runway Lights need attention – some are not working. This will be corrected during the Saturday work party.
