## May 2016 Meeting

- The meeting was called to order at 7:05 PM at the Dover Valley Restaurant, Dover, PA by President, Matt Leubecker, with 16 members present.

- Discussed shirts to be ordered – Decided on Red Shirts for this year.
- Ron will order the portable toilets for the flight line.
- Judy solicited volunteers to get donations from local businesses to use at our raffle.
- Need more small stuffed animals for our Bear from the Air toy drop.
- Jim had removable tattoos of our logo made and we can sell them at the fly-in.
- Face painting and a clown will again be on site this year.
- Possibility of the Tri-motor doing a low pass around noon on Saturday.
- Bugler will be on site again this year.
- Ron said that the 21<sup>st</sup> of May there will be a fly-in at Shippensburg.
- Denny said that the Golden Age Air Museum will be on June 11<sup>th</sup> which is a week before the Father's Day Fly-in.
- We ask Glenn, who has a business as a One Man Band, if he would provide music for the Father's Day Fly-In dinner on Friday evening. He graciously agreed.
